1	Say "Pause there. Tent your books. Question #"	 Tent their books Take out their written response packets Turn to the appropriate question # Clear their desks of their folders Pick up their pencils

7	Say: - Pencils Down, Hands Up Scan to see that all students have stopped writing and are raising their hands Redirect any students as necessary	Put their pencils down Raise their hands and wait to be called on
